



## North Cumbria ICS Development

NECS played a major supporting role in the turnaround of the North Cumbria system and its establishment as a second wave ICS pilot site. We supported the development of a shadow integrated care organisation as 'operational' commissioning functions (blending CCG/NECS services) transitioned from CCG to become integrated with equivalent functions in the newly merged North Cumbria Integrated Care NHS Foundation Trust.

In NE&NC ICS, NECS is formally recognised as a strategic partner with a permanent seat at the Management Group and System Leadership Forum. Our support has been wide ranging and has included:

- Senior specialist input into system leadership and workforce diagnostics to deliver PHM infrastructure.
- Provision of a PMO for the ICS and management support to a number of ICS work streams (i.e. mental health, prevention, digital, communications, workforce and PHM).
- Senior specialist input: the NECS Managing Director is joint SRO for PHM with the Centre Director for Public Health England in the North East, NECS Business Information Services Director is a member of the Great North Care Record Board and the NECS Corporate Services and OD Director provides specialist input to the HR and workforce steering groups.

## Specialist PHM support

- Developing/implementing PHM Strategy
- Investment in five new embedded Public Health Consultant posts driving the population health agenda
- Development of PHM RAIDR with population segmentation/risk algorithms dashboards reporting at PCN, ICP, ICS levels
- Supporting design and delivery of PHM leadership development programme for PCN Clinical Directors, sharing valuable learning gained providing PHM delivery in North Cumbria and the Suffolk and North East Essex ICS.
- Provision of a PHM Analytics programme to all 66 PCNs in NE&NC, consisting of workshops, training sessions on tools, an "insight summary" produced for each, and tailor-made, clinically led analytical deep dives covering a range of themes, including, frailty, falls, smoking/COPD, A&E – Self harm, stabbings, cancer screening – HPV uptake, deprivation, childhood obesity, childhood Immunisations, Care homes/111, Alcohol/Drugs, Mental Health and MSK/Social Prescribing
